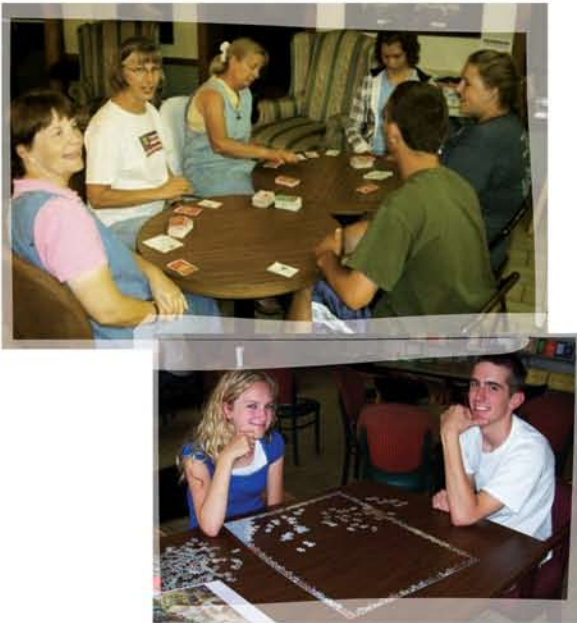


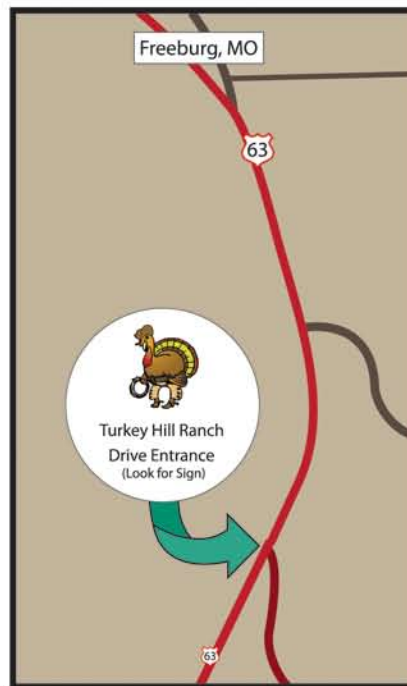
FELLOWSHIP
